Individual Supplies:	Community Supplies
 Two 1 ½ inch binders that have a plastic cover where papers can be inserted. Colors don't matter. 1 bound composition notebook A graph paper notebooks (4x4 quad square one-subject kind are best; look inside to see if the ink is dark or light. Try and get the lightly colored ones – they work better with pencil markings). One pack of college-ruled loose paper. Pre-sharpened or mechanical pencils Pack of binder dividers Pencil pouch (this will cover from class to class) Handheld pencil sharpener 2 packs of standard coloring pencils Two 3-prong folders for Specials classes Approximately \$4 for a sturdy plastic folder that will be the home/school folder (if not lost, this folder should last through all of middle grades). If you have a flash drive already, please bring it. If not, a small one is good for backing up files.
