## General Student Supplies



- Composition Notebook (The kind bound by sewing.)
- Plastic, 3 pronged, pocketed folder to use for home/school communications and as a planner. Students may continue to use last year's "Homey Folder". Students may wish to use their own planner instead.
- Pencils and erasers (and optional pens)
- Loose leaf notebook paper
- Colored pencils and/or markers to keep for yourself or to add to and use in the class supply
- 1 composition book
- Optional – students are welcome and encouraged to use their own computers or tablets in class according to the rules of each teacher

Social Studies Wish List

- Low -temp mini hot glue gun sticks
