<p>Refillable Water Stations/ RO</p>	<p>Tanya</p>	<p>Partnership has discussed that if Fund the Wonder is a success, that they could help fund refillable water stations. We have gotten information of what that would look like and cost.</p> <p>Adding Reverse Osmosis (RO) filters is a significant added cost.</p> <p>Potentially: Use the students (leadership, another grade level, etc.) to do a fundraiser for the stations.</p> <p>Installing 3 refillable water bottle stations is desirable because they reduce water waste, and encourages reusable water bottle use.</p>

Growth and proficiency were solid last year. We progressed back from a C to a B school. Lori reminded the committee that this is only one data point of many that we look at, but that we are pleased to see our efforts are working. - Lori shared CFCI's Family Engagement Policy and the committee members will take the policy over the next month and look for any recommended edits/changes as well as begin brainstorming any possible barriers for parent engagement. Technology Update		<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Parent voiced concern over weight of Chromebook in bookbag- Lori shared that the weight of the Chromebooks range from 2.9-3.6lbs. Students typically take home the Chromebook, one folder or notebook and possibly a book they are reading. Typical school text books weigh 3-5lbs, so the chromebooks are a much lighter option.- CFCI takes all medical concerns into consideration and we encourage any parent to share with CFCI teachers/admin if there is a medical concern that the school needs to be aware of/ make accommodations for.- The committee discussed the understanding of children with small frames along with the benefits of rolling bookbags and sturdy backpacks with waist straps as well.- Lori shared that teachers at CFCI are always looking at ways to ensure we are teaching children how to appropriate use technology, using it to create, collaborate, explore and share with the global community as our philosophy outlines and encouraged PCN members to have parents dive into the technology website if they have not had a chance. https://cfci.net/technology
