Updates: - Covid Ad-Hoc - Plan A - Family Engagement - Covid Updates	Kim	At the 2.24.21 Covid Ad-Hoc meeting, the committee will discuss Plan A/Full-Time and create a survey for parents. Some parents are asking about returning to Plan A. The Governor wants kids back in school following CDC guidelines. As of October 2020, NC K-5 public and charter schools may choose to return in Plan A with proper precautions. Middle and High Schools are still limited to Plan B/Hybrid. Given CFCI is K-8, the circumstances for returning full time are more challenging. <u>Covid Updates</u> : CFCI's covid Dashboard includes a composite number of all, positive, suspected, and quarantined cases of students and staff. The data are included in the weekly community update (email).
New Director Search - PCN involvement - Survey to families - Timeline	Kim	Currently 8-10 candidates for Director are being selected for a Zoom conference interview on March 3 <sup>rd</sup> . Then the Board will select the top 4-5 for an in-person site visit and interviews with several groups: Board, Teacher, Parent (PCN) and maybe a few students.
School Directory Update	Kim	Chose <b>Directory Burst</b> platform. Ben Rose is currently setting it up.
Lottery	Kim	The school lottery happened 2.16.21. This year we used <b>Lotterese</b> , an online platform that meshes with Power School. Given all the applicant information is digitized, the lottery process and slots are automatically configured and uploaded to Power School if they choose to enroll. There were 329 applicants, down 40 from 2020.
