Making Friends

Making friends can be hard! Social skills don't come naturally to all kids, especially those with ADHD. Impulsivity and hyperactivity can sometimes make it difficult to interact with others. Check out the following tips on how to help your child make friends:

- According to the Child Mind Institute, coaching your children at home is one of the best ways to help them make friends. Practice taking turns and managing frustration. Practice with role playing different ways to handle disagreements.
- Teach your child how to apologize, so they will be ready to handle disagreements with friends. Read How To Apologize by David LaRochelle for practical tips for young children on how to say sorry.
- Talk about friendships with your children. Discuss what they have to offer in a friendship, and what they value from a friendship with others.
- Read the Making Friends series by Kristen Gudsnuk for older children, and Making Friends is an Art by Julia Cook for younger children.
