

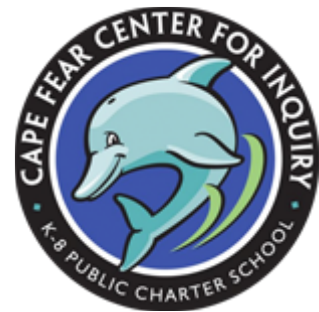
CFCI Community Update

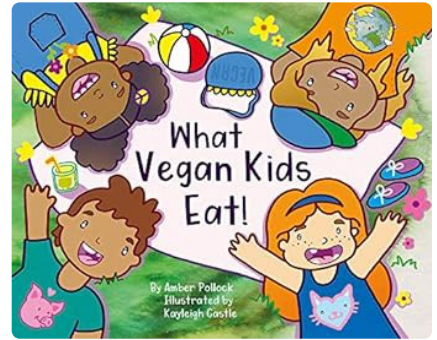




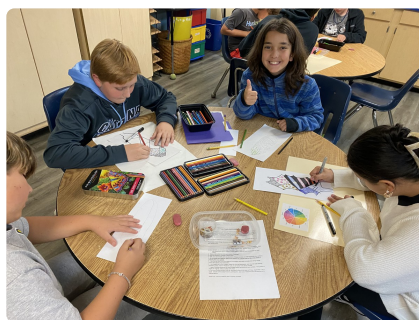
Ms. Jordan's Class Learned About Vegan Eating Thanks to Henry's Parents! YUMMY!
