Dear Families of Students in Grades 1, 3, 6 and new students to CFCI (grades 1-8),

The following screenings will be taking place on Thursday, 9/28. You must return a signed permission to have the vision screening completed by our Vision Partner, The Lions Club.

Hearing

Screenings are completed by trained school staff and will provide follow-up for all failed hearing screenings.

Vision

Vision is screened by the trained Lion's Club Screeners and/or by trained school staff on all students in grades 1, 3 and 6.

Students at any grade with evidence of problems related to hearing or vision will be screened or re-

assessments will be rescreened.

What is the Role of The CFCI Board of Directors? CFCI Board of Directors

The CFCI Board of Directors is a self-perpetuating Board, comprised of seven voting members including parent/guardian members and members of the broader community. In addition, there is a Partnership seat, 4 faculty/staff seats, a Founder's seat, and the Co-Directors of CFCI, who sit on the Board as non-voting community members. Each director serves for a three - year term.

The Board's role is to provide academic, fiscal, and policy oversight as it upholds the school's mission and vision. The Board is responsible for hiring and evaluating the Co-Directors on an annual basis. The Board of Directors meets monthly (with training/orientation generally taking place in July). These meetings are generally held the 3rd Tuesday of the month. In addition to these meetings all Board members are required to serve on at least one of four Board committees (Finance/PPRC, Executive, Lifelong Learning, Instructional Technology). Further, all Board members are expected to support fundraising efforts and outreach on behalf of CFCI.

- Give examples of how to use a growth mindset
- Define accountability
- Describe why positive self-talk can be a helpful tool
- Use "I-feel" statements to express various emotions
