The following document may be used by school leadership to determine potential actions and/or consequences for student behaviors exhibited in the learning environment (this also includes field trips, buses, and any school-sponsored activity). It is understood that any potential consequence will be applied to actions that happen after teachers have provided core behavior management and instruction to students.

These core principles include, but are not limited to:

- Redirect, Remind, and Restore
- Warnings
- Time and Space/Reflection Forms
- Conferencing
- Office Referral

Any consequences will be applied after a thorough investigation and discussion among school leadership. This guide is purely a reference tool, all decisions are at the discretion of school leadership, once all factors, including but not limited to IEPs, behavior plans, and 504s, are taken into account. The list below is purely a starting point and not exhaustive; other student behaviors can occur, as well as other consequences can be given.

*Continued breaking of general school rules may be considered "refusal to follow school procedures".
